What scholarship(s) are available?

Scholarship(s) up to \$12,500 (total) are available to students from the College at Rindge.

- 3- \$3,500 Tuition Scholarships
- 4 - \$500 Book Scholarships

The scholarships will be awarded to students who meet the following criteria:

1. Must be enrolled as a full time matriculated student making satisfactory academic progress at the College at Rindge for the 2008-2009 academic year
2. Candidate must demonstrate financial need, with information provided by the alumni relations and student financial services offices of Franklin Pierce University (confidential information will not be released to members of the Scholarship selection committee)
3. Student should demonstrate participation in campus or professional activities

2008-2009 Academic Year Timeline

- **December 2008** ~ application forms available
- **March 2, 2009** ~ applications due to the Student Financial Services Office
- **April 3, 2009** ~ applicants notified of scholarships awarded

The Decision Process

Members of the alumni association are asked to volunteer to serve on a committee responsible for reviewing the scholarship applications. Each member of the committee reviews each of the applications individually and submits votes to the committee chairperson. The committee chairperson tallies the votes and forwards the results to the alumni relations director.

What is the alumni association?

The purpose of the alumni association is to "promote the general welfare of Franklin Pierce University; to develop an enduring interest in all the affairs of the University throughout its alumni, undergraduate, former students and friends; and to develop an organization, which shall be the means of creating and maintaining the close association of Franklin Pierce men and women."
