



Robert Alvin Scholarship in the Performing Arts

Robert Alvin Scholarships are awarded annually to matriculating freshmen who have an interest in participating in Music, Theatre and/or Dance at Franklin Pierce University. Two, scholarships will be awarded in each discipline. Scholarships are \$2000.00 each and are renewed annually. In order to be considered for this scholarship, a student accepted for admission to Franklin Pierce University must:

1. **Complete the following information and submit with all required material postmarked by March 20, 2009.**

2. **Provide a performance and training resume.** This should include, but is not limited to: a list of roles or solos, performance location, name of persons with whom you have studied, concerts in which you have played a part, and awards that you have received.
3. **Two letters of recommendation,** one from a teacher in your performing arts discipline and one from a person of your choice whose input will help the selection committee evaluate your eligibility. If you are applying in more than one area, there should be a letter from a teacher in each area, and one other person of your choice.
4. **For Application in Music:** Provide an audio or video recording of your performance of music from the standard repertoire of your instrument or voice, not to exceed ten minutes in length.
5. **For Application in Dance:** Provide a VHS videotape or DVD that shows five minutes of technique in any dance style plus an additional section showing a short solo dance. In addition, performance in a group piece may be included, in which case you must indicate clearly which dancer you are by costume and position. Clarity and visibility are important in our ability to assess your performance.
6. **For Application in Theatre:** Provide a five minute VHS videotape or DVD that includes two contrasting monologues and/or contrasting scene work. A live theatre performance may be substituted, in which case you must indicate clearly which actor you are by costume and position. Clarity and visibility are important in our ability to as-
