A Reminder About Travel Outside New England

Travel increases a person's chance of exposure to COVID-19 through contact, directly or indirectly, at public areas such as restaurants, stores, gas stations or rest area.

In the continued effort to keep cases of COVID-19 low on the Rindge Campus and in accordance with the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services requirement, we are sharing the following guidelines on travel:

- Franklin Pierce University has, and will continue to enforce a 14-day quarantine for all students when they return to campus, from any travel that may take them outside of New England (New England consists of New Hampshire, Vermont, Maine, Massachusetts, Connecticut and Rhode Island.)
- Those who would need to quarantine post-travel may do so on campus or at home, if home is within New England, and will be required to be tested on day 5 and 10 of quarantine. If you choose quarantine at home, the testing will be at your own expense.
- You will not be permitted to return to campus or regular activities until test results are received and you are cleared.
- If you choose quarantine at home, you must meet with Health Services Professional Staff member prior to returning to classes and your residence hall. Health Services is available to meet Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. At this meeting, you will have a final test administered and you must sign a document acknowledging you followed the 14 day quarantine and provide an address for where you stayed.

Be aware that a negative test result while in quarantine, whether on campus or at home, will not reduce the 14-day requirement.
