Dear Colleagues:

Governor Sununu announced at his press conference yesterday that the state of New Hampshire's mask mandate will expire today, Friday, April 16, as death rates continue to drop and vaccines become more widely available.

The New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services (NHDHHS) continues to recommend health and safety guidelines including social distancing and mask wearing, as cases and hospitalizations remain high.

The Franklin Pierce University community will continue to maintain all our health and safety guidelines established in the fall, including mask wearing in all settings, unless otherwise directed. A message on this topic has also been sent to all Rindge students.

As the communities and business around our Campus may no longer enforce mask wearing, we encourage every member of our community to remain vigilant and continue to wear masks, practice social distancing and proper hand hygiene.

Franklin Pierce will also continue our robust COVID-19 testing through the week of Commencement.

As we enter the final weeks of our spring semester, maintaining the overall health and safety of our students, our faculty and our staff remain our top priority.
