New Hampshire's Governor Issues Stay-at-Home Order

Since March 18, Franklin Pierce University has committed to diminishing the spread of COVID-19 by encouraging staff and faculty to work remotely. Certain offices remain open and designated essential employees continue to work on the Rindge campus.

Yesterday, New Hampshire's Governor Chris Sununu issued a stay-athome order that will go into effect tonight at 11:59 p.m. and remain in effect until May 4. Since the University was already operating in accordance with this and federal directives, yesterday's announcement does not require new action. As indicated in the March 17th update from President Mooney, more information for employees will be provided early next week.

In consideration of those essential employees who are continuing to work on the Rindge campus, please do not come to campus if you are sick, are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or have been exposed to someone who may have COVID-19.
