Doctor of Humane Letters

Janet Judge is a distinguished pioneer in sports law and a fervent advocate for educational and athletic equity. Her impressive career spans over three decades, during which she has adeptly navigated the complex intersections of higher education, legal advocacy, and sports administration.

A four-time recipient of the Best Lawyers in America Sports Lawyer of the Year award, most recently in 2024 for Boston, Ms. Judge's excellence in her field is universally acknowledged. As co-founder of the Education & Sports Law Group, LLC, Ms. Judge has diligently served a diverse range of higher education institutions and NCAA conferences. Her expertise in NCAA compliance, civil rights issues, and specifically Title IX athletic equity compliance, has established new standards in the field.

Her involvement in developing the NCAA's Gender Equity Manual and her ongoing efforts to create impactful training materials underscore her commitment to fostering fair and safe environments in collegiate athletics.

Ms. Judge's contributions extend beyond legal advice. She is a strategic advisor who has significantly influenced policies and practices at hundreds of colleges and universities, enhancing their ability to support and protect all students. Her work has been pivotal in promoting sexual misconduct prevention, addressing hazing, and combating harassment, thereby safeguarding the well-being of student-athletes and bolstering the integrity of educational institutions.

Ms. Judge's advocacy and contributions are deeply aligned with Franklin Pierce University's mission and values, helping us to foster inclusivity and fairness within our campus community.

Tom Rush

Doctor of Humane Letters

Tom Rush is widely regarded and credited by Rolling Stone magazine with pioneering the singer-songwriter era, marked by its focus on intimate narratives and profound sentiment. With his evocative vocals and masterful songwriting, Rush imparts a powerful reflection on the fleeting essence of life and the value of embracing each moment without hesitation.

Mr. Rush's 1968 song "No Regrets" epitomizes the genre's ethos. Covered by artists including Emmylou Harris and U2, the beloved standard helped solidify Rush's status as a pivotal figure in music history.

A native of Portsmouth, New Hampshire, Tom Rush began his music career in 1961 while attending Harvard University. His early influences included Southern and Appalachian folk, old-time country songs, Woody Guthrie ballads, and acoustic-guitar blues, which he skillfully integrated into his performances at venues such as Club47® in Cambridge, The Unicorn in Boston, and the Franklin Pierce College Field House on November 16, 1968.

Mr. Rush's impact on the music industry transcends his own musical creations. He has played a pivotal role in launching the careers of icons like Joni Mitchell, James Taylor, and Jackson Browne, while also influencing artists such as Bonnie Raitt, Tracy Chapman, and Garth Brooks. His Club47® initiative seeks to foster the development of the next generation of musicians through collaboration between established artists and emerging musicians.

For seven decades, Tom Rush has used his place at the intersection of the arts and social commentary to address complex issues, highlighting the role of artists as both influencers of public sentiment and recorders of their era. His career demonstrates that music's power extends beyond entertainment; it also serves to reflect and influence societal narratives. Mr. Rush's recent albums, *Voices* (2018) and *Gardens Old, Flowers New* (2024), showcase that enduring spirit.

"Tom is often credited with having ushered in the singer-songwriter era," says Matt Nakoja, Rush's producer, accompanist, collaborator, and friend. "But as I see it, he continues to lead the charge."

Whereas, in recognition of his unparalleled contributions to the folk and blues genres, his pivotal role in shaping the singer-songwriter tradition, and *whereas* his spirited commitment to advancing the arts in ways that resonate with and inspire societal reflection and change, Franklin Pierce University is proud to confer upon him the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*.

The Honorable Walter R. Peterson Citizen Leader Award

The Honorable Walter R. Peterson Citizen Leader Award was created to honor the late Governor Peterson's lifelong commitment to public service and higher education in the state of New Hampshire. He served two terms as the Governor of New Hampshire and was Franklin Pierce University's second President from 1975-1995. He also was President Emeritus of the University until his passing in 2011. This award, presented at the annual Commencement Exercises, is intended to acknowledge and to honor an individual for his or her extraordinary commitment to public service, selfless contributions to higher education, sense of humor, and high moral character — all characteristics of the award's namesake.

Eliezer Rivera '97

Sheriff Eliezer “Eli” Rivera '97, made history in 2012 as the first person of color to be elected as the High Sheriff of Cheshire County, New Hampshire. Throughout his tenure, Sheriff Rivera has been at the forefront of developing and implementing a community-focused strategy within the sheriff's department, emphasizing respect, strong community relationships, service, and equity in law enforcement practices.

Much like Governor Peterson, Sheriff Rivera is known as a good person with a big heart who brings people together in order to bridge differences that effect real change. An outspoken advocate for human rights, Sheriff Rivera has dedicated his efforts to address critical issues including systemic racism, LGBTQ rights, and immigration.

Across Cheshire County, Sheriff Rivera plays an active role in numerous organizations including the Kiwanis Club, The Community Kitchen, the Monadnock United Way, and the Monadnock Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging Coalition. His collaborative work with Franklin Pierce University on race and policing issues underscores his commitment to justice and community engagement at every level.

Academic Regalia

Caps and gowns are a link with the early universities of the Middle Ages. In a time when all students were clerics, the gown and its attached hood served the dual function of keeping the student warm in unheated buildings and of identifying the particular order to which he belonged.

Modern academic regalia in the United States is based on an intercollegiate code established in 1895. The gown is commonly black, differing slightly according to the level of the degree. The baccalaureate gown has long pointed sleeves and is worn closed. The master's gown is designed to be worn open or closed and is distinguished by its oblong sleeve open at the wrist. The doctoral gown also may be worn open or closed. It has long, bell-shaped sleeves and is paneled in velvet with three matching velvet bars on the sleeves. The velvet may be black or a color distinctive of the degree conferred: Ph.D., blue; M.D., green; etc. Trustees wear doctoral gowns.

Caps are usually of the mortarboard style and are retained on the head throughout all academic exercises except during prayer when the men should remove them. The tassel on the mortarboard cap may be black or of the color indicating the degree. The doctor's tassel is gold. The tassel is worn over the left front quarter of the cap once the degree has been awarded.

The hoods are satin lined with the colors of the institution which conferred the degree; Franklin Pierce hoods are crimson and gray satin. The color of the velvet border indicates the subject to which the degree pertains.
