Commencement Reminder: Graduates Line-Up at 9 a.m.

All graduating students should line up at 9 a.m. in Spagnuolo Hall on Saturday, May 15 for Commencement.

Why? We need to make sure all graduates are checked in, lined up, and robed before the procession begins at **10 a.m.**

Please see our other important reminders below:

• **COVID Testing: All participants must do one of the following:**

1. Be tested on the Rindge campus on Tuesday, May 11. Testing is open from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. in the Fieldhouse, no registration needed; or
2. Provide a copy of completed vaccination card to healthservices@franklinpierce.edu; or
3. Provide documentation that you have previously tested COVID positive either on or after February 5, 2021; or,
4. Provide a negative PCR COVID test taken within 72 hours of the May 15 Commencement ceremony, with results emailed to healthservices@franklinpierce.edu to remain eligible to participate.

- **Remember to bring your cap and gown!** If you haven't picked it up yet, it will be available the morning of at check-in at Spagnuolo Hall.

- **View our [updated map](#) for parking and location information.** Graduates from off-campus may park in the student lot.

Rindge residential students should take the Shuttle from Lakeview to upper campus. The Shuttle will start running at 8:45 a.m. and continue until 10 a.m.

We will close our Campus entrances at 10 a.m.
