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### **CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION TRACK**

#### **EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP**

This program prepares educators with skills that provide the background to lead in a broad range of educational settings, looking forward to the needs of the future. Through a common core, elective courses, and fully implemented action research projects, leaders can design an educational plan that meets individualized professional goals. After completing core courses, students will select from an array of electives to build expertise in a content area which supports the individualized action research project.

Each Master's degree is comprised of 36 credits. The general M.Ed. in Educational Leadership has six required courses and six electives. Areas of specialization, such as Curriculum and Instruction, may have more required courses.

#### ADMISSION TO THE PROGRAM

You must have a Bachelor's degree from a regionally-accredited college or university generally with a GPA of 2.8 or greater on a 4.0 scale. Applicants with a 2.50-2.79 CGPA may be eligible for provisional acceptance. GRE/GMAT tests are not required, and there is no application fee. Assessment of a completed Admissions Portfolio required, as noted below.
