- Equivalent of four years of science with a final grade of B+ (87/100) or higher in each class
- Demonstrated leadership in community and school-based activities, which may include involvement in athletic, club, community service, and work activities. Related healthcare experience is highly desirable.
- For additional favorable consideration: Resident of a rural and/or medically underserved area, or healthcare experience with populations from a rural and/or medically underserved area (paid or volunteer).
